Season timing

- Whale watching season in Cabo San Lucas generally runs from December through April.
- January, February, and March are often strong months, while exact activity varies by migration pattern, weather, sea state, and port conditions.
- Whale activity is natural and never guaranteed. A private charter improves comfort and flexibility, not certainty.

Private route expectations

- Private whale-season charters typically depart from Cabo San Lucas Marina and can include Land's End, El Arco, Medano Bay, and open-water viewing areas when practical.
- Captains adjust the route around wildlife activity, wind, swell, port guidance, guest comfort, and respectful viewing distance.

Planning notes

- Cabo Yacht Co. states that it operates whale experiences with SEMARNAT certification and supports ECOBAC conservation work.
- Use source-safe wording for conservation and permitting claims unless the exact external proof URL is attached.
- Send date, group size, desired timing, and whether whale watching is the main goal or part of a broader private yacht charter.
